The Manifesto outlines steps calling for equitable treatment of contingent faculty.

Member Smith also asked if there was any official limitation to the number of courses adjunct faculty could teach at Cape Cod CC. The Executive Board members concurred that they were unaware of any official directive limiting adjunct sections. Health insurance benefits for adjunct faculty could come into play with the federal healthcare reform once the IRS determines how to assess adjunct workload.

Monthly General Meeting

Member Smith mentioned that several MCCC chapters hold monthly General Meetings. The Executive Board held a brief discussion about holding General Meetings more than once a semester.
