Chapter Elections


The chapter election turnout was low despite the convenience of online voting. The Executive Board discussed ways to involve members in union activities including a new member reception in the fall.

Adjunct Initiative

The Executive Board discussed the adjunct situation with regard to under-enrolled courses and course cancellations. DCE MACER will discuss the situation with management and suggest a more flexible pay policy for courses that do not have an enrollment of 12. Many of the low enrolled courses are upper level courses and some fields are having problems recruiting qualified faculty. Any new pay policy would need to be uniformly applied. Inconsistency with adjunct appointments and notifications is also problematic.
