President's Report:

President Barnes reminded members of the primary for the U.S. Senate seat on April 30, 2013. The MTA has endorsed Ed Markey, who supports education, gun control, and clean energy.

- The spring CCCCA social event off campus was poorly attended. The Executive Board would like suggestions from chapter members about the timing and venue of union get-togethers.
- The change in Human Resources leadership has presented challenges for CCCCA leadership. MACER has been active in reporting problems with fall the schedule.
- The Boston Foundation Report on Massachusetts' community colleges seems to be having influencing state legislators. CCCC Trustees are discussing the report.

The situation for ORP members remains the same; the BHE is still waiting for an IRS ruling about the legality of allowing ORP members a one-time chance to buy into the SERS system.

Professional Staff Committee Report:

Mary Jenkins reported that the Professional Staff Committee is having regional meetings and working on developing Level 7 job descriptions in several areas.

DCE Negotiations

DCE Negotiation Team member Betsy Smith reported that the team has been meeting regularly and is working on the DCE member survey. The first meeting with management will be in May.

Grievance Report:

Grievance Officer Guarino reported that several day grievances have been filed; one was settled to the grievant's satisfaction at the local level.
